

**At St Wilfrid's we support parents wishing  
to send their children to Bishop Luffa School.**

Church schools provide a real Christian environment for young people to explore and foster their faith. **We don't want anyone to be disappointed in their application.**

In order for you to get a place in Bishop Luffa school you need to be in the first category. In some years there are a few places in the lower categories but this is usually not the case.

There are two ways to qualify either through the Parents attendance at Church or the Child's.

**ADULT**

1. Adults must be communicants.
2. Weekly attendance (3 out of 4 Sundays which leaves space for holidays), at either a Sunday or weekday act of worship. This is over a two year period preceding the application due date. It is no good suddenly coming more often before the application is due in. We have to record the pattern over the whole two years.

**Or CHILD**

1. Weekly attendance, (3 out of 4 Sundays which leaves space for holidays), at either a Sunday or weekday act of worship. This is over a two year period preceding the application due date. It is no good suddenly coming more often before the application is due in. We have to record the pattern over the whole two years.

Many parents write in depth why they wish their children to come to Bishop Luffa however this is not necessary. The admissions committee only look at the pattern of attendance at Church not at any other information. (<http://www.bishopluffa.org.uk> for more details)

Parents need to keep up their attendance for any future sibling entries.

Above all don't get your application in late as you go to the bottom of the pile, even if you already have a child in the school!
